This is a training facility mainly for the youth, which was established in commemoration of the 1964 Tokyo Olympics.



- ◆ The facility is spacious and rich in nature for Tokyo. It has conference rooms and lodging, but its facilities are not hotel-like. Thank you for your understanding.
- ◆ There is one large cafeteria. Also, there are small coffee shops where you can have light meals.

There are several ways to get to NYC from Narita/Haneda Airport. For further information, please check the NYC transportation guide.

- ◆ From the airport, it is convenient to go to JR Shinjuku Station or Busta Shinjuku and take a taxi to the NYC.
- ◆ Limousine bus services from the two airports to the Busta Shinjuku are also available.
- ◆ There is also a train available from Narita to Shinjuku Sta. via Keisei Liner and JR Yamanote line.
- ◆ We will prepare an information card to show to the taxi driver so that you don't need to explain where you are going by yourself. The information card will be in both English and Japanese, and will lead to the main gate of the NYC venue.

Practical Information in Japan

There are signs in English in major stations and people who can speak English are increasing, especially at stations, hotels and shops.

- ◆ The weather will still be hot at the end of September, but it's a good idea to bring a light jacket.
- ◆ There may also be typhoons or autumn rains, so please prepare an umbrella or rain jacket.
